Introduction:

How can your DNA tell if you're related to someone?

Paternity testing looks at the DNA of two people (often a father and a child) to determine how much of their DNA is the same and how much is different. If the two people share more DNA with each other than would be expected, the test will be positive: they are highly likely to be father and son.

DNA is the material that carries all the information about how a living thing will look and function. For instance, DNA in humans determines such things as

what color the eyes are and how the lungs work. Each piece of information is carried on a different section of the DNA. These sections are called genes.

DNA is short for deoxyribonucleic acid. DNA is in every cell of every living thing. DNA is found in structures of the cell called chromosomes. Both DNA and chromosomes are tiny. Scientists need to use very powerful microscopes to see them.

Functions

When DNA works correctly, it helps keep the body functioning properly. DNA helps cells to make the substances called proteins, which the cells need to live. DNA also allows living things to reproduce. The genes in DNA pass along physical traits from parents to children. Sometimes there are mistakes in DNA. These mistakes are called mutations. They can cause diseases and other problems.

Structure

DNA has a complex structure. It is made of chemical substances that are linked together like a chain. Each piece of DNA has two long strands, or chains. The two strands are joined together. They form a shape like a ladder that has been twisted into a spiral.

Chemicals called phosphates and sugars make up the sides of the ladder. DNA also has chemicals called bases. Each base on one strand is joined to a base on

the other strand. The linked bases form the rungs of the ladder.

Genetic Code

There are four different bases in DNA: adenine, thymine, guanine, and cytosine. (I ask the medical people in the house to forgive me if I mis-pronounced those names.) These four chemicals are repeated in different orders over and over again in each strand of DNA. Human DNA contains about 3 billion pairs of these bases.

The order in which the bases are arranged is very important. It forms a code that tells cells to make certain kinds of proteins. The differences in these proteins is what makes different living things—such as a cactus, a gerbil, and two different people—different.

Isn't it amazing that God's creative brilliance makes us unique and special individuals although we are all similar in our collective humanity?

But - God also created a special Spiritual DNA to show our relationship to Him. It is dissimilar to our relationship with each other because this special Spiritual DNA only reveals our relationship to Him. It doesn't have anything to do with cells, or

chromosomes, no chemicals, no phosphates, no sugars, no coding.

Just blood! But - not our blood. Our opportunity to be a child of God is made possible by the blood of Jesus, His one and only Son. It is by the sacrifice of His blood that our heavenly Father welcomes us into His family.

The unique features of our spiritual DNA have little to do with our humanity and everything to do with our spirituality. Only the Bible gives us insight into this special DNA.

No other book or manual, no medical dissertation, no University study, no human think tank can locate this DNA. In fact, in most cases, they actually deny its existence.

Galatians 3:26
